Holocaust Memorial Day, we heard the story
of Steven Frank, a Holocaust survivor who was
just five years old when the Nazis targeted his
family. Steven shared how he and other
Jewish families were forced to wear yellow
star badges and banned from certain
places. He also spoke about being sent to a
prison camp and the strength of his mother in
keeping their family together. After the war,
Steven arrived in the UK and later met with
pupils to share his experiences. This assembly
reminded us of the importance of respect,
kindness, and standing up against
discrimination. The key message:

"We are all different, but we should be respectful of one another."
